2nd annual Ladies Day 15kg Tag & Release Billfish Competition

An official 2019 Argonaut Billfish Shootout - Pre-Fish competition

Saturday 25th May 2019

RULES

- Boating teams must consist of at least one member of the Nickol Bay Sport Fishing Club (NBSFC), or Hampton Harbour Boat & Sailing Club (HHBSC) or King Bay Game Fishing Club (KBGFC).
- Only female anglers are eligible for capture tag points, other team members may assist with the capture of the fish such as skipper, deckie, linesman, catching bait and tagging.
- To maximise billfish survival rates: 15 Kg IGFA line class applies with No additional points awarded for fish caught on line classes less than 15Kg. Current IGFA game fishing rules apply, single hook rigs only lures included, live bait rigs must be non-offset circle hooks
- Each team must contain a minimum of 2 members with at least one adult. No purely junior teams will be allowed.
- A working VHF marine 2-way radio must be installed on the boat. Channel 21 will be monitored.
- Tag and release competition only, NSW Department Primary Industry's Gamefish Tagging Program billfish tags only to be used. Should you require tags please contact: Ken MacFarlane, or Wayne Summers NBSFC Tag Master by phone on 0427 861 156 or Mick Grasso KBGFC Tag Master on 0402 237 993.
- Scores 750 points for a sailfish, 1000 points for a marlin 2000 points for billfish other (photo proof required for BF Other).
- Late tags will not be accepted unless extenuating circumstances can be shown to the satisfaction of the organiser.
- Fishing in local Pilbara waters within 70 nautical miles of the HHBSC ramp.
- Tag cards must be filled in entirely and correctly to be counted for points. All details must be provided including capture location, line class etc. Completed tags to be submitted to your Club's Tag Master post competition.

FISHING TIMES AND TAG SUBMISSION:

- Fishing times, lines in at 7.00am and lines out at 3.00pm (15.00) Saturday 25 May and tags to be presented to the scoring coordinator at the Hampton Harbour Boat and Sailing Club between 4pm and 5pm to be eligible.

SAFETY:

- The competition may be cancelled should bad weather or hazardous conditions as determined by the competition organiser be likely. In this event, entry fees will be refunded.
- The skipper of the vessel is ultimately responsible for the safety of all crew and passengers.

PRIZES:

- There will be prizes from our sponsors for the 3 highest point scoring anglers. Should a score be the same between anglers a count back system will decide the winner i.e the first angler to the score wins.

ENTRY FEE: \$25 per boat (team) which includes a simple BBQ at the Sunday 'Tag in'. Fee must be paid prior to competition start or Tags do not count.

Tagged Billfish must be reported to the Ladies Day Billfish Competition fleet.

Skipper/Deckie to radio the competition fleet on VHF CH:21 and report each tagged billfish within 1 hour of capture: eg:

"All boats fishing the NBSFC Ladies Day Billfish Comp', this is (boat/team name). We'd like to report a tagged (Sailfish/Marlin) for angler (name) at (1.00pm), out".
