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RULES:

1. At least one team member must be at briefing night at HHBSC on the 14th of October 2023 at 1900, an Attendance form will need to be signed on arrival.
2. Lines in the water 0530 on the 15th October 2023.
3. All fish to be presented at the HHBSC weigh station between 1600 - 1700 on 15th October 2023 to be eligible. Multiple fish can be weighed by an individual angler providing legal bag limits have not been exceeded.
4. Presentation will start at 1800 at Hampton Harbour Boat and Sailing Club.
5. Only one prize eligible, per fish. If 1 fish is the heaviest in 2 categories, that fish will only win the prize of the highest value.
6. All WA fisheries regulations apply, including minimum length sizes and bag limits. Anyone found to be breaking these rules will have all their fish disqualified.
7. Rod/reel are the only acceptable fishing method.
Use of electric reels, nets, long lines, set lines, spears, or traps will be instant disqualification.
8. Teams must consist of a minimum 2 people, one of which must be 18yrs or older.
9. Commercial fishing vessels will not be eligible to enter this competition, with the exception of charter boats, please contact NBSFC organisers if you have any queries.
10. In the event of a draw where two or more fish are weighted at the same weight the first fish weighed at the gantry will be the winner on count back
11. Eligible *Scomberomorus* mackerel species include.
 - Narrow Barred Spanish Mackerel:
 - School/Spotted Mackerel
 - Broad Bar Mackerel
 - **However**, Wahoo and Shark Mackerel are not included, these are **not** *Scomberomorus* (mackerel) species
12. Fish weighed in late will not be accepted unless exceptional circumstances are demonstrated acceptable to the event organiser.
13. Fishing within 60 nautical mile radius of HHBSC see map attached.
14. All fish must be fought and captured by the angler without assistance from any other team member.
Assistance from other team members that is allowed includes leadering and gaffing/netting.
15. ANSA 6Kg line class category winner will be the angler who weighs the heaviest mackerel on 6kg pretest. ANSA sportfishing rules apply. Rods and rigs, including hooks/lure, leader and double line used for that capture, must be presented to the weighmaster when presenting the fish. 16. Fish to be presented in an edible condition to the satisfaction of the competition weigh master. Fish that are not presented in an edible condition or have not been kept cool prior to being presented will not be accepted.
17. Any fish with mutilation from sharks, propellers etc, will not be counted as an eligible fish.

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
